**Agape Meal** – Be the hands and feet of Jesus as White's Chapel volunteers (ages six and up) serve a meal to the homeless on the third Thursday of each month at Broadway Baptist Church in Fort Worth. Volunteers gather at the east Welcome doors at 4:15 p.m. to ride the church bus or meet the group at Broadway at 5:30 p.m. We will return to White's Chapel by 7:45 p.m. Register on the church website.

**Cooking with Care** - Typically on the 2nd and 3rd Monday of each month, men and women join in planning, buying, preparing, and serving meals to the parents, siblings, and family members staying at the Ronald McDonald House in Fort Worth. Currently, the number of volunteers is limited to ten participants on each service day. Volunteers must bring a valid driver's license. **Community Awareness Training/Outreach** – White's Chapel has partnered with the Poiema Foundation to help bring awareness to the growing problem of domestic human trafficking through education and action. Each month, outreach teams of trained volunteers distribute posters of vulnerable, missing minors to strategic business locations throughout our local area. Businesses are encouraged to call the tip line on the poster if they see one of the missing youth. Each team consists of an experienced team leader, a driver, a data collector, and a prayer warrior. After completing a one-hour training, you will have an opportunity to be a part of an outreach team from 10 a.m. to noon. Registration is required and can be found on the church website. **Filling the Gap** – This is a 3-part volunteer opportunity for our weekend food program for our Adopt-a-Schools. On Mondays, there is a group that picks up the food order and delivers it to WC. On Tuesdays, volunteers are welcome to come to the Concourse at 8:15 a.m. to help set up and/or at 10:30 a.m. to sort food items and pack bags to be delivered to the schools. In between you can register for Pastor John's Bible Study and breakfast from 9-10:30 a.m. Every Thursday (Bellaire) and Friday (O.H. Stowe), registered volunteers will meet at the school at 10 a.m. to place the bags of food into labelled backpacks and deliver to the respective teacher classrooms.

**Patriot House Monthly Birthday Celebration** – Help us make birthdays special for homeless veterans! On the last Thursday of each month, from 4-7:30 p.m., volunteers will celebrate monthly birthdays while enjoying fellowship and dessert at Patriot House, a transitional housing facility for veterans run by the Presbyterian Night Shelter in Fort Worth.
